Papers should be preceded by a short abstract and will normally have the following sections: brief Introduction; Materials and Methods; Results; Discussion; Acknowledgements and References. Past issues should be consulted for a suitable format.

Information should not be repeated in the text and in tables or figures. The legends to tables and to figures should be sufficiently detailed for the information to be understood without reference to the text. All figures will be printed in black and white. Authors will have to pay for colour printing. Citation of unpublished reports is not permitted.

**References** should be given in alphabetical order with the **full title of the journal**, for example.
